

MATERIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Each piece in the Borrowed Earth Bath Collection is crafted from natural stone, making it inherently unique. Variations in color, veining, texture, and natural fissures are a testament to the material's natural origin and are embraced as part of its beauty, not flaws or defects.

Borrowed Earth celebrates the perfect imperfections of each block of stone, honoring the natural veining, mineral inclusions, and occasional fossils that make every piece distinct. These elements highlight our commitment to sustainability and a ZERO WASTE INITIATIVE, which involves carving multiple elements from a single block wherever possible.

SEALANTS AND PROTECTION

Pieces in this collection are not pre-treated or sealed with any protective coatings. Clients who prefer additional protection may choose to apply a sealant after installation. A professional stone specialist can provide guidance on selecting and applying a sealant suited to the specific material and environment.

Re-sealing may be considered over time based on usage and exposure to water, but it is not mandatory.

MATERIAL HANDLING Natural stone is heavy and can be fragile. Proper handling equipment and techniques, such as lifting straps or dollies, should always be used during transportation and installation to prevent damage or injury.

Professional installation is highly recommended to ensure the product's safety, proper alignment, and long-term performance.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE	Clean stone surfaces using a soft, damp cloth or sponge and mild, pH-
	neutral stone cleaners. Avoid acidic cleaners (e.g., vinegar, lemon) or harsh
	chemicals, as they can etch or discolor the surface.

Spills should be wiped promptly to avoid staining, especially for porous stones like marble or limestone.

Avoid abrasive scrubbing tools or sharp objects that may scratch or damage the surface finish.

HEAT, MOISTURE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY

While durable, natural stone is sensitive to prolonged exposure to extreme heat or direct sunlight, which can cause discoloration or structural stress over time.

Borrowed Earth's natural stone products are designed to age gracefully, with changes in tone and texture over time adding character and authenticity to the material.

INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

Waterproofing is essential for areas exposed to frequent water contact, such as bathrooms, to protect both the stone and surrounding surfaces.

Only adhesives, grouts, and installation materials compatible with natural stone should be used to prevent chemical reactions or weakening of the product.

Custom pieces may have slight dimensional variations due to their handcrafted nature. On-site verification of dimensions is recommended before installation.

CUSTOM AND PRE-ORDERED PRODUCTS

The Pieces of Borrowed earth bath-ware collection are made to order and are non refundable nor returnable once the order is placed. Clients are encouraged to confirm all details before finalizing orders.

INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

We offer white glove delivery service only. An estimate of delivery costs will be provided based on Delivery address and specific requirements when consulted with your account manager.

Clients are invited to inspect at the time of unboxing when delivered and keep a visual record for any visible damage from transportation and refuse if damaged. This ensures satisfaction with the materials unique characteristics. Including veining texture and finish.

Once the pieces leave the warehouse, Borrowed Earth cannot offer refunds, replacements, or exchanges. Proper inspection and approval are key to ensuring client satisfaction.

Goods shall be deemed to have been delivered from the moment the Seller has informed the Client that the goods – whether or not to be assembled in full or in part – are ready for collection from the Seller or a third party or for shipment at the order of the Client. From the moment of delivery, all risks associated with the delivered goods transfer to the Client.




GUARANTEE

If the Seller (or the seller's supplier) provides a guarantee to the Client with regard to the work or goods delivered or to be delivered by it, it shall explicitly inform the Client of this in writing. If the Seller notifies the Client that it will proceed to repair the goods, the Client shall, at its own cost and risk, put the delivered goods at the disposal of the Seller.

All guarantee obligations of the Seller shall cease to apply if the defects or imperfections in the supplied goods as put forward by the Client are the result of (i) any incorrect, careless or incompetent use (including dropping or hitting the product) or management of the goods by the Client, their representatives or third parties; (ii) a modification of the delivered goods to which the Seller did not agree by the Client, their representatives or third parties; or (iii) any external causes such as, but not limited to substances such as acid, fire or water damage.
